Quest Event Registration/Participation FAQ

(revised 2/5/2008)

- 1 – Can Venturers from outside Area 4 attend the Area 4 annual event?
 - Yes. Out-of-area Venturers are welcome. You can participate in everything, except voting in the area election.
- 2 – Can we bring guests who are younger than Venturing Age?
 - No. This event is designed to appeal to young adults. The target audience is the high school and college age group, with emphasis toward the older (17 to 20 year old) Venturers.
- 3 – Can a Boy Scout troop or venture patrol register and attend?
 - No. Boy Scouts may only attend as members or guests of a Venturing Crew or VOA/TLC.
- 4 – We are having trouble getting adult leaders, but our crew wants to attend?
 - We can work with you to help overcome this problem by helping you connect with another crew, usually from your own council. If you have other special needs please contact us – we will do our best to help you.
- 5 – We do not have camping gear or tents, but this event sounds like fun....
 - The Quest is for all Venturers, not just outdoors-based crews. We have cabin space for 90 people. The cabin space will be allocated first come, first served, so register early. Food is served in the dining hall, so no worries about cooking or other camp chores.
- 6 – Cabins – can we reserve our own cabin (or at least keep crew members together)?
 - There are only four cabins, with about 90 total bunks. We will do all we can to keep people together with their friends. Cabins will be designated as Male or Female.
- 7 - Registration Deadline - Our Venturers have a hard time meeting deadlines. Why so early?
 - In order to keep the event fee as low as possible we need to know how many are attending - before ordering the patches, t-shirts (on time deadline) and food (final deadline) and other supplies. We will not have extra food, so please do not show up without advance registration
